HEATERS AND DOORS

It is starting to get cold outside so for those of you that are new, we try and keep all garage doors closed and take our horses in and out of the door openings instead. It helps keep the heat in the barns. All of our horses are taught to go through the door openings. Please practice with your horse by entering and exiting from the center doors as much as possible. We will be testing the heating systems when the horses are outside and the temperature is a steady 35 degrees. Once the inside of the barns reach 35 degrees, the heat will be turned on. Please use the center barn doors for entering and exiting the arena bldg. If you are not sure which doors they are please ask the trainers or myself and we can show you.
